Q. Should the Letter of Intent to Subcontract/Coverture be addressed to the prime consultant or CCDC? If the latter, should it be addressed to you specifically, or someone else?

A. It should be addressed from the Prime to the subconsultant.

Q. This is in regards to the CCDC RFQ for the Downtown San Diego Parks, Open Space and Recreation Master Plan. On Sheet C.7-1 (Subconsultant and Vendor List) in the Estimated Dollar Amount of Contract column we typically put a *percentage* of total contract amount for each subconsultant, because a final scope of work is determined after award of the contract. Please let me know if this is acceptable.
